Purpose of this meeting is to find out who and how much taxes are paid by property owners. Reasons why those optioned lands from the Government should be bought. Reason is to give the Indians home and 2nd , the people will be taken off the relief list.

We Indians voted in favor of the Act because we would like to support ourselves.

Discussion on school taxes.

Ordered the Secretary to write the Supt. Christy for school proposition.
