Chauncey Adams March 12, 1937.

House called to order at 8 o'clock P.M. by the chairman Morris Wheelock. The purpose of this meeting was to hear report of the second call at Appleton with County Board's Committee of five men namely:

Chairman, Mr. Shaefer, opened the meeting at 9:30 o'clock a.m. at the County Court in Appleton Wisconsin.

Mr. Hooks reported his work concerning government programs. Lawyer G. Clifford of Green Bay, Wisconsin opposed this program but Mr. Hooks comes right off, that he will buy land wherever the government wants him to etc. Resolution was agreed upon that Town Board will cooperate with government program set up for Oneida's.
