Meeting apened by the chairman Morris Wheelock , the purpose of this meeting is to hear different reports about the new Deal. Senator W Wheeler was not able to kill the New Deal at Washington D.C. Senator Fazier not even able to prove his bill against the New Deal.

We might get \$4 or 50,000 for project work for our people taking up 40 to 60 acreas, we need to plan how to use this money. We might put up cheese factory.

A letter was read from Washington D.C. that who ever voted for the constitution and bylaws, and voted for it's officers are the legal representatives of Oneida Indians,

Report on the last call at the court house at Appleton is concerning Meditation Board was read. Cooperation was their resolution, while-se white - settler's petition against the government program was 538 signatures.

Chairman; Reorganization Act was meant for a good cause for us from different stand points, morally, mentally, socially, spiritually, and even politicully.
