

Minutes of the Executive Board meeting on September 21, 1937. at the home of Morris Wheelock .

Meeting was called at 7:45 p.m. by the Chairman. The Executive board met in session with Mr. Purew Farver Supt of the Tomah Indian school and Mr. Allen Collins, together with the executive board and discussed the various forms of land assignments and building sites.

The first order of business was discussion of four different forms of land assignments and through the executive board the forms were referred to the General Tribal Council for approval or disapproval. Sup't. Farver then explained the four types of forms.

The second business in order was building sites. The executive board discussed and the various sites for the new houses, sizes and types of homes to be built and repairing of the various homes of the Oneida Indians on the reservation.

The meeting adjourned at 10 o'clock P.M. subject to the call of the chair.
