MINUTES

Special meeting called by Chairman Julius Danforth at the CCC Camp at the request of Mr. E. J. Riley.

First on the order of business was approval of a release by Harrison Skenandore. Motion was made by Irene Moore to approve an application for land assignment for Leland P. Lewis and also for the release signed by Harrison and Isabelle Skenandore in favor in favor of Leland P. Lewis. Motion was seconded by Arthur Schuyler. Carried.
(Land assignment described as T. 23 N. Range 19 E, Section 19)

Discussion was held concerning the trust land and building belonging to the former Anne and Lehigh Cornelius. Mr. Riley advised Council to check on the standard form C-G. to find out what the status is in regards to the buildings on this as the house was not paid for. Mr. Riley said that if the house is not paid for the title is the final say on house whether to rent if liveable or sell if not liveable.

He also suggested that the heirs be notified of the action to be taken and they thought they should be given a first option to buy. If the heirs did not want to buy, the house should be put up for sale to be owned by the tribe. Notices should be posted in three public places with 10 to 30 day notice on this.

Council discussed a letter from Mr. Riley and Mr. Schuyler, dated May 10, 1960, Mr. Riley, but no one present knew of his background as to parentage so Mr. Riley stated he would check further on it for enrollment purposes.

Mr. Riley suggested that the minutes of meeting and the land certificate be mailed to the heirs and also to the tribe for their information.

Eva Danforth discussed the contract on her house and stated that they were charged \$200. over and above the appraised value at time of acquisition. Mr. Riley said that she should contact the members of board who were council officers at that time and get statements from them and then the Executive Committee could make a decision if it is justified. Other wise he suggested bringing it up before the General Council.

Council discussed the plan to use the CCC grounds for pow-wow purposes. After much discussion Mr. Riley and Mr. Hall decided they would have specific changes in contract in regards to insurance for this. Contracts to be sent back to Committee as soon as possible.

Discussion held concerning cleaning the CCC building. Irene Moore said she would see Mrs. Minnie Danforth about cleaning the bldg. and also talk to Mr. Moore about getting the pump fixed at CCC.

James Schuyler volunteered to bring the corn bread from Sarah Skenandore's place.

Irene Moore was asked to contact Sarah Skenandore about corn bread and see what kind of deal she could make with her.

No other business on this date. Meeting adjourned.
