Minutes of meeting held by – Executive Council

Name and title of council members present – Julius Danforth – Chairman, Irene Moore – Vice Chairman, Altheas Schuyler – Treasurer, Eva Danforth – Secretary

Minutes

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Julius Danforth.

Secretary gave a report of the May regular meeting and two special meetings.

Motion made by Althea Schuyler to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.

Treasurer's report read as follows:

Rehab fund: \$958.62

Tribal Fund: \$228.23

Motion by Irene Moore to accept treasurer's report, seconded by Eva Danforth. Carried. Council discussed the land use program with the following assignees: Delbert Moon, Clifford Doxtator, Austin Summers, Charles B. Cornelius as it was noted that they had not been making use of their assignments. All reported that they are going to use their land, but with the past rainy season, they have been held up at present. Mrs. Harriet Alicia, Phillip Skenandore, John Petersand, Rachel Corn sent notices that they are planning to plant their land. Council discussed the assignment of James Smith with him, but it was decided that any action would be tabled in his regard until the land committee checked on his assignment. Leo Danforth had been sent a notice about his loan and land assignment, but Council had no reply from him.

A motion was made by Eva Danforth to give Leo Danforth a 30 day notice on his building loan and land assignment and if he hasn't done anything by that time, they will be revoked. Seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

A motion was made by Irene Moore to send John Peters and Delbert Moon a 6 months notice that they must show some improvement on their land or give it up. Seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

At the request of ? B. Cornelius, Council agreed to make necessary arrangements for his son to be beneficiary at the July meeting.

A motion was made by Irene Moore to give Abraham Webster a 30 day final notice on his land assignment as he does not use it and this committee has no reply from him of his intentions, seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

Treasurer reported that Lester Skenandore got the balance of his loan in the amount of \$390.00

Council acted on a loan agreement on behalf of Peter and Martha King. A motion was made by Irene Moore to pay Andrew Parker, Jr. a partial payment of \$300.00 on house purchase for Peter and Martha King. The total amount being \$785.00 with balance to be paid Mr. Parker when funds are available (Rehab. Fund). Seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

Four birth certificates were submitted for enrollment: Carol Ann Skenandore, Micheal James Skenandore, Irene Miriam Benson, and Patricia Lynn Skenandore. Motion was made by Irene Moore to accept the four certificates, seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

Motion was made by Irene Moore to post notices for bids on the former (Lehigh) Cornelius house, as the heirs were notified that they had first option to buy, but did not give any reply, seconded by Eva Danforth. Carried. Bids are to be opened on Tuesday evening June 21st at 8:00 o'clock, C.C. C. Camp.

Motion by Eva Danforth to pay Simon Moore \$5.00 for fixing pump at C.C. C. Camp, seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

Motion by Irene Moore to authorize Treasurer to purchase 30 postal cards for insurance coorespondence, seconded by Eva Danforth. Carried.

Motion by Irene Moore to pay Lester and Althea Schuyler to carry benches and tables back in the C. C. C. building, seconded by Eva Danforth. Carried.

Council discussed the coming caucus meeting which is to be the second Saturday in July and the semi-annual tribal council meeting. A motion was made by Althea Schuyler to have the semi-annual meeting on July 5th rather than the fourth as it is a holiday. Seconded by Eva Danforth. Carried. Secretary advised to post notices in no less than three places ten days prior to this date. Also to notify Mr. Riley, Superintendent of this date.

Motion was made by Eva Danforth to adjourn, seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.
