No birth certificates submitted for enrollment.

Motion made by Althea Schuyler that a notice be sent to Abe Webster that his land assignment is revoked, seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.

Motion by Eva Danforth to authorize treasurer to purchase stamps in amount of \$3.00, seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.

Motion by Irene Moore to borrow \$40.00 from Rehab. To cover expense of November meeting, seconded by Eva Danforth. Carried.

Motion by Eva Danforth to refund Isaac Peters \$1.94 for stove pipe. Carried.

A motion was made by Eva Danforth to have Althea Schuyler and Irene Moore go collecting on loans for tribe over due, seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.

Motion by Eva Danforth to adjourn, seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.
