Vickery to attend our Tribal meeting to be held at the Oneida Methodist Hall on Jan. 4, 1965 to explain the Opportunity Act to the Tribal members. He excepts the invitation. Er. Potter takes pictures of those present at this meeting to be put in the paper put out by the Ashland Agency Office. Notion to adjourn by Los MoLester. Seconded by Hoodrow Hebster. Carried Meeting closed at 10:15 p.m.
