Present: Chrm. Norbert Hill, Vice Chair Lee McLester, Secretary Woodrow W. Webster

Reading of the minutes of the January meeting approved as read. Lee McLester makes a motion to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by Woodrow Webster. Motion carried.

Mrs. Hanson Denny offers to turn her property over to the tribe explaining that she is finding it increasingly difficult to work and keep up her taxes. A discussion followed. Lee McLester makes a motion to accept the property if possible. Seconded by Woodrow Webster. Motion carried.

A paper of release was written out which she signed pending outcome of acceptance of property.

Reading of letters from tribal lawyers informing us of further delay in payments of tribal claims from the government. Another letter informing us that our timber claim has been disallowed.

Letter informing us of employment assistance officers visit on February 16, 1965.

? Reed letter concerning her annuity check which she did not receive. Ernest Smith informs us that the check was returned to Ruth Baird by the party who received it by mistake.

A discussion on U.S. Public Health Service requirements on septic tanks, water, etc.

A discussion on Economic Opportunity Act.

A motion to adjourn by Lee McLester. Second by Woodrow Webster. Motion carried.
