Leslie Lanforth requests permission to clear his land. He explains that Mr. Bunker, a non-Indian, wishes to use about 4 acres of cleared land for which he will clear out about 4 acres more or less. A discussion held on the legality of such a proposition. It was decided to have Chairman Hill call the agency and ask Mr. Riley about the legality of this deal. Lee McLester makes a motion to accept the proposition if it is passed by the agency. Seconded by Woodrow Webster. Carried.
