

Special Meeting  
September 12, 1967

The meeting was called to order by Chrm. Purcell Powless at 9:50 p.m. at the hotel Northland in Green Bay, Wisconsin

Oscar Archiquette states that Indians suffered a great loss of land because of white man's laws. It follows that the Indian is still afraid to deal with the white man for fear of losing what we have left. He further states that if there is any default on the part of the industrialist, that the Judgement Fund of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin be immune.

Discusson held on advantages and disadvantages of the Oneidas building a building on the Industrial site and leasing same plus land to a prospective industrialist.

Oscar Archiquette makes a motion that the Oneida tribe lease tribal land to Mr. Bethea with building thereon to be built by the tribe and this motion be subject to final approval by BIA Ashland office. Second by Loretta Ellis. Motion carried.

Motion by Oscar Archiquette that he amend above motion to read resolution. Second by Loretta Ellis. Motion carried.

Motion by Oscar Archiquette that we table Mr. Don Peccorick's proposal until the BIA Ashland office gathers more information. Second by Loretta Ellis. Motion carried.

Discussion held on Mr. Peccorick's business.

Motion by Oscar Archiquette that the Executive Council request the BIA develop plans for Industrial Park. Second by Loretta Ellis. Motion carried.

Motion by Oscar Archiquette that the Oneida tribe request the BIA Ashland office to clear cut 27 tract proposed Industrial site. Second by Loretta Ellis. Motion carried.

Motion by Oscar Archiquette to request Economic Development Administration to make survey of stone quarry. Second by Loretta Ellis. Motion carried.

The long range possibilities of a Golf Course, Chinaware Industry and Museum were mentioned.

Motion by Loretta Ellis to adjourn, seconded by Oscar Archiquette. Motion carried.
