

Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc.  
Special General Tribal Council Meeting  
August 14, 1968

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Purcell Powless at 8 p.m. at Holy Apostle's Parish Hall.

Council members present: Chrm. Purcell Powless, Vice Chrm. Oscar Archiquette, Sec. Loretta Ellis

Because a quorum was lacking, a general information session was held.

Mr. Patrick Flynn reports that on July 18<sup>th</sup> the overall completion of the 20 mutual help units was 60.8% and that the completion as of this date is 61.5%

Dean Sickles reports that they are setting a target date of September 30 for finishing 10 units with the first five to be assigned to those participants who have the largest number of hours to their credit. He also reports that by that date the loan of \$148,000.00 will be reduced by 25%, leaving a balance of \$111,000.00.

Executive Council goes into emergency session:  
Loretta Ellis moves that we accept resolution no. M-10-A with the stipulation that the word executive be inserted between the words tribal and council. Seconded by Oscar Archiquette. Motion carried.

A building bee was suggested by Mrs. Bob Thomas. Food could be brought by those not working. A timekeeper is suggested. Participants may donate time to specific person or divide among others.

Question was raised whether or not there is work available for women. Answer: yes.

The Bee will take place this Saturday, 17 August. The Housing Authority announces it will pay for lunch. Need ladies to prepare.

A Vista Potluck supper was announced by Anna John to be held Monday, August 19<sup>th</sup> at 6 p.m. This will be a going away affair for Vistas Tamar Golan of Israel and Maria Guerrini and Margarita Giraldo of Argentina, also a welcoming for new Vistas John Sherwin and Charlotte Owens.

Motion by Oscar Archiquette that we adjourn. Second by Loretta Ellis. Motion carried.
