A special meeting with the Housing Administrative Assistant for Future Housing Projects was called to order by Chairman Purcell Powless at the St. Annes Convent in Oneida. Members present: Chairman Purcell Powless, Vice Chairman Irene Moore, Secretary Amelia Cornelius, Treasurer Joycelyn Ninham and Dean Sickles.

It was requested by Mr. Sickles that the Council approved the resolution for 30 future low rent houses in the amounts of 15 family units and 15 elderly units for Oneida. to be started in the spring of 1969.

Joycelyn Ninham made a motion to accept the Resolution Approving Application for Preliminary Loan for Low Rent Public Housing. Second by Irene Moore. Motion Carried.

Council request that a letter be written to the B.I.A. to find out the rules, regulations and policy of the Council with regard to the Housing Authority.
