The meeting was called to order at 3 p.m.

Joycelyn Ninham made a motion to pay bills. Second and carried.

Amelia Cornelius made a motion to accep the 2 acre lease for Theresa Melchert and her son Gary on the former assignment of Malohais Smith. Second by Joycelyn Ninham. Motion carried. (Res. 69-01)

Amelia Cornelius made a motion to accept the 1.25 acre lease for Elmer and Donna VandenBloomer on the former Inez Grignon assignment. Second by Joycelyn Ninham. Motion carried. (Res.69-02)

Amelia Cornelius made a motion that the proceeds from the 1969 Folk Fest go to the Oneida band to help buy equipment, second by Joycelyn Ninham. Motion carried.

Joycelyn Ninham made a motion that the secretary write a letter to the town chairman of Oneida and Hobart in support of a curfew because of the increased vandalism in and around the Oneida area. Second by Amelia Cornelius. Motion carried.

Amelia Cornelius made a motion to pay for the tribal lawn mower, second by Joycelyn Ninham. Motion carried.

It was suggested by VISTA Helen Henderson to write a letter of thanks to Miss Judy Severson for her help in conducting the California tests.
