The meeting was convened at 7:30 p.m.

Minutes for the month of Sept. read and approved.

Treasurer Report read and approved.

Discussed the situation of Rudy Webster living at the CCC Camp bldg. Irene Moore was delegated to collect rent of \$30.00 for the month of Sept. and Oct.

Discussed the posting of no trespassing and hunting signs on tribal lands.

Explanation about the Industrial Committee. It is just a sub-committee of the Business Committee and consists of the same members of the Industrial Corporation.

Mr. Sonnenburg of AAIA, an Industrial specialist is to meet with the Business Committee, Industrial Committee and interested persons on Oct. 14.

It is noted that there are now 4 Indians working at the park now.

Payment of \$110.20 from Mrs. Peter Danforth received. Paid in advance for 4 months.

Read letter from the Minneapolis office in regard to the Wisconsin claim award

Joycelyn Ninahm made a motion to adopt the resolution 69-06 to reinvest the claim award for another 6 months. Second by Ira Cornelius, motion carried.

It was decided to question the BIA on why the Stockbridge Munsee Tribe had not met the July 1st 1968 deadline for enrollment on the Claim award.

Member of the Employment Assistance Branch will be in Oneida on Oct. 9, 1969.

VISTA trainees have now graduated to full fledged VISTA and will now be working in the Oneida area except for Kay Gass and Kathleen Skenandore.

John Sherwin gave a report on the tutoring program. He would like to use the gym on Mon., Tues., and Wed. evenings.

Irene Moore made a motion to allow the VISTA to use the building on Mon., Tues. and Wed. evening for tutoring. Second by Gordon McLester. Motion carried.

Larry Bernstein would like to start the Community Newspaper. He would like the tribe to consider buying stamps on the bulk rate prices of \$30.00 per year and \$15.00 for stamper.

Wendell McLester reported on the Legal Aid Society funded by county tribe could use them for legal aid.

Read letter in regard to dismissal of community worker Evelyn Danforth.

Read minutes for the Oneida Housing Authority.

Ira Cornelius made a motion to pay bills, second by Joycelyn Ninham. Motion carried.

BIA tis going to have a Communications Seminar on Oct. 15 in Ashland.

Motion by Ira Cornelius to have Rudy Webster pay \$30.00 a month rent and lite bill for CCC Camp retroactive to Sept. 8, 1969. Second by Gordon McLester, moiton carried.

Received voting registration list for election on Oct. 18, 1969.

Motion to adjourn, second and carried.
