BUSINESS CONDUCTED:

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman. Norbert Hill made a motion to defer voting on the moving of the Apprenticeship Center until a complete evaluation of the Center is made by the Oneida Business Committee. Irene Moore seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Loretta Ellis made a motion the 701 Comprehensive Planners develop a workable program for the disbursement of the Emigrant Claim, to be reviewed by the Oneida Business Committee and presented to General Tribal Council on January 6, 1973. Norbert seconded the motion. Motion carried, 5 for, 1 abstain.

The Chairman appointed Norbert Hill, Jr. Chairman of the Education Committee to replace John Powless, Jr.

The Chairman appointed Amelia Cornelius to replace John Powless, Jr., on the 701 Comprehensive Planners staff, and Margaret Doxtater as clerk.

Loretta Ellis made a motion that the 701 Planner, Purcell Powless, has the authority to appoint staff members, and that all other jobs, newly created or any other jobs that become vacant and are sponsored by the Oneida Tribe, be advertised for 2 weeks for the Oneida Indians. (Purpose of the motion to clarify action taken on August 18, 1972 relative to this same subject.) Irene Moore seconded the motion. Motion carried, 4 for, 1 against, 1 abstain.

The Chairman reaffirmed Loretta Ellis's appointment to the local Education Committee.

Irene Moore made a motion the Tribe request an additional \$10,000 through Indian Health Services for the Dental Program. Loretta Ellis seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Loretta Ellis made a motion to adopt the resolution requesting the Town of Hobart take over and accept on a 100% maintenance basis the Oneida Community Road at Oneida Housing Site 1. Irene Moore seconded. Motion carried.

The Chairman appointed Loretta Ellis to obtain the Annuity Treaty and develop a workable investment program.

Gordon McLester appointed Purcell Powless to report on the Law enforcement Officer in Outagamie County.
