Chairman Powless called the meeting to order. Discussion of Vista Program. Irene Moore made a motion the Tribe write a letter of support for the Vista Program, listing priorities and goals and request 4 local Vista workers and 3 National. First priority to be for Industrial Development. Norbert Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion of land assignments. A letter was sent to Johnny Reed informing him he is in violation of his lease.

Applications for residential leases for Sherry Cleveland and Sandra Lee Peveles. Council decided to hold these applications pending an opinion rom the Solicitor.

Norbert Hill made a motion to hire Irene Moore as C.A.P. Coordinator. Eva Danforth seconded. Motion carried, 4 for, 1 abstained..

Amelia Cornelius presented the Health Center Program to the Council. Norbert Hill made a motion the Tribal Business Committee be the Board of Directors for the Health Center. Eva Danforth seconded. Motion carried.

Irene Moore made a motion Howard Cannon keep his survey team working until the money alloted for them is used up. Norbert Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion of Corporate Charter of the Oneida Tribal Fund. Norbert Hill made a motion to adopt the Corporate Charter. Irene Mocre seconded. Motion carried.

Gordon McLester made a motion a special meeting be held at the Oneida Nation Memorial Building on Oury 29, at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of interviewing applicants for the Secretary-Receptionist position. Eva Danforth seconded. Motion carried.

Eva Danforth made a motion to adjourn. Irene Moore seconded. Meeting rdjourned.
