The Oneida Tribe is applying for prime sponsorship in accordance with the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973. The Stockbridge Chairman requested to be included with Oneida. Loretta Ellis made a motion that Stockbridge be included. Irene Moore seconded. Motion carried.

Contingent on their consent

LAND BUSINESS

Loretta Ellis made a motion to table Robert Thomas' assignment of lease to Kellog Bank contingent on proper land description. Alma Webster seconded. Motion carried.

Eldred Nicholas requested his lease be modified. Alma Webster made a motion to table this until Mrs. Nicholas' signature is obtained. Loretta Ellis seconded. Motion carried.

Irene Moore moved to approve Gary Cornelius' residential lease. Loretta Ellis seconded. Motion carried.

Loretta Ellis moved to approve Wayne Cornelius' residential lease. Alma Webster seconded. Motion carried.

Loretta Ellis moved to refer Leland Powless' residential lease back to the Land Committee for alternative solutions and recommendations. Alma Webster seconded. Motion carried.

Alma Webster motion to adjourn. Irene Moore seconded. Meeting adjourned.
