Continuation of April 1, 1976 meeting in regard to the Oneida Tribal Management System.

Personnel Selection Committee. Discussion of present system. Recommendation by consultants that Business Committee members be the Selection Committee.

Motion by Norbert Hill to dissolve the present Personnel Selection Committee with appreciation for their service. Second by Ruth Baird, motion carried.

Motion by Mervin Jordan to select 3 Business Committee members as the Personnel Selection Committee, motion second and carried.

Joy Ninham moved to rescind the previous action that the Administrator could not be a Business Committee member. Motion second and carried.

Discussion of minutes of Feb. 13, 1976 as they now relate to the Chairman having been delegated the responsibilities of the administrative duties.

Discussion of tribal sovereignity. Rick Hill moved to adopt a Resolution for an ordinance in regard to law suits and employee conduct. Motion second and carried. Resolution for Ordinance # 4-2-76-A Ordinance will also be added to Glossary of Terms as a Cause for Suspension or dismissal.

Joy Ninham moved to have a standard Report Form for Program Directors to submit to the Business Committee. Motion second and carried.

Mervin Jordan moved to amend and revise the Oneida Tribal Management System by Resolution # 4-2-76-B. Motion not second: It was decided to wait on action until Business Committee has finished book with all changes.
