

Meeting was called to order at 1:10 p.m. Purpose of the meeting was to find out and resolve some of the current problems in the garbage business.

When the Director resigned his position recently, Chairman Powless placed Dave Smith in charge. Problems include truck breakdowns and staff conflicts. Questions revolved around employees work hours and their lack of information regarding Tribal fringe benefits. There were also questions concerning alleged promises the Director made to some of the employees.

Discussion ensued about ways to accomplish coordination of efforts so that we ultimately comply with our contracts. Following agreements will apply: (1) It is understood that garbage will be picked up by other trucks if one breaks down. (2) All crews agree to work together in the best interests of honoring our contracts. (3) All truck supervisors are responsible for their crew's hours, for their truck's maintenance and for recording daily activities. (4) Joey Christjohn, by agreement of all present, will be the Director for 60 days on a trial basis and Ralph will be a supervisor. (5) Joey will be responsible for: (a) maintenance of all trucks, (b) timesheets for all staff, (c) setting internal work rules (d) hiring and firing, and, (e) establishing route maps, customer names and billing.

Motion by Edwin to adjourn. Seconded by Pat. Meeting adjourned at 2:35 p.m.
