Discussion on Treasurer working fulltime. The Controller and Tribal Treasurer are key people in the accounting office. Every effort should made to get Wendell on full time. We will have to make funds available. Mark made a motion to bring on the Tribal Treasurer full time. Norbert seconded the motion. Vote was 5 for with 1 abstention. The salary was for \$15,000.00.

Headstart Request: Reguest for temporary employment. Mark moved to table request. Myron seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Mark moved to adjourn at 6:10 pm. Norbert seconded. Meeting adjourned.
