Motion was made by Edwin that Norbert attend the N.T.C.A. and that he bring all important action for our consideration. Mark seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Norbert that Loretta be appointed to the State American Indian Language Culture board. Mark seconded. Vote was 3 for with 1 abstention (Loretta.) Motion carried.

Motion was made by Mark to deny the request by the National Guard for a demenstration project on the recreation field at Oneida. Edwin seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Edwin that the BIA use the proper bidding process and to furnish copies of bids to the Business Committee those bids that were submitted for all HIP projects. Mark seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Meeting ended at 10:45 A.M.
