John Powless explained what his functions as General Manager are and gave some back ground experience on himself.

John stated his role as General Manager will eliminate Program Director's present at Business Committee meetings, this would allow the Committee to spend more time on day to day Tribal activities. Monthly reports will also be eliminated, instead, quarterly reports will be required and will go to the General Manager who will submit to the Business Committee. Liason persons will be advisory to their specified programs. Program Director's are to meet with the General Manager on all issues before it is brought to the Business Committee. The major reason for this is to allow the Business Committee time to develop guidelines/strategies to address many issues facing the Tribe.

John will also get to know State and Congressional people to improve the relationship with them and also so that the Tribe can have some input on our views and opinions.

Any Program Director's that need advice should contact the General Manager, so that things can be accomplished as a team. John stated he would like to meet with all committees/boards to explain his role and find out who is on what committee.

John will be reviewing and updating the Redbook, with input from Program Director's. Program Director's are to send a copy of the federal regulations for their programs to John.

Starting today the General Manager will be signing time sheets. They are to be sent down to the Personnel Office for review.

Discussion on employees that are absent on Friday's also discussed was the need for time-clocks, John stated Program Director's should use their own judgement if time clocks are needed for their program.
