Executive Session with Francis Skenandore at 9:43 - 10:18.

Discussion of attorney expense accounting and reporting. Reply was that existing system was gone over several times and that it was established in agreement with former administration. Also was worked out with accounting office. Committee asked for monthly itemizing of expenses. Francis agreed to comply.

Frank asked if Tribe is supporting his private business and if upkeep of library can come partly out of attorney's budget. Francis replied that he is handling only one case in Federal Court where library might be used. Other cases - primarily traffic violations - do not require use of library.

Question was asked as to how Tribe can get Housing answerable to Tribe. Frances replied that the Housing Authority is set up by the Feds. and is answerable directly to H.U.D. However, no reason why agreement can't be made to obtain data for Tribes financial statement.
