Bruce King gave a report on the construction of a building to be leased to the Energy Marketing Group in the Industrial Park. Frank moved to approve the recommendations from Bruce for this project:

- (1) Look at a ten year payback schedule
- (2) That we look at a 12% return on our investment
- (3) That we finance the construction ourselves.

(4) That the Tribe grant me permission to negotiate the lease at a beginning rate of between 3.95 and 4.05 with an increase in two (2) years. A five year lease with an option on the next five years.
