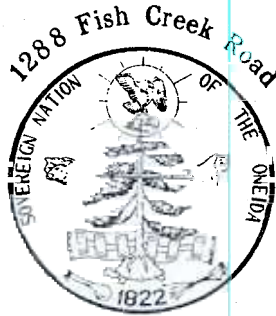


Oneidas bringing several hundred bags of corn to Washington's starving army at Valley Forge, after the colonists had consistently refused to aid them.


PURCHASE PRICE OF HOUSE FOR FRANK AND MARGARET D
