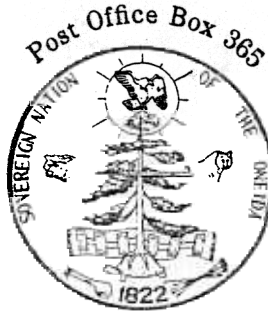


Oneidas bringing several hundred bags of corn to Washington's starving army at Valley Forge, after the colonists had consistently refused to aid them.

Loretta made a motion to pursue the garnishment ordinance at 20%. Kathy seconded Lloyd opposed. Motion carried.


10:30 A.M. Conference scheduled for Marsha Baker.
