060-CHANNEL 11 - Jerry Horen

Jerry Horen gave a presentation on how Channel 11 was going to be covering the 350 years of Green Bay's Heritage. They have thirty (30) second announcements running in June, July and August that are selling as sponsorship identifications.

050-VEHICLE MAINTENANCE - Bob Archiquette

Bob Archiquette gave a report on the possibility of developing a Vehicle Maintenance Enterprise at the Maintenance Garage. Gordon Skenandore would be the employee who will be doing the service work on the vehicles. The following is the limit of services:

- 1) Tune Ups
- 2) Oil Change Oil/Air Filter Specified
- 3) Grease Jobs
- 4) Tires
- 5) Tire Repair
- 6) Erakes
- 7) Exhaust Systems
- 8) Car Wash

There will be a \$15.00/hr charge for labor outside of oil changes which will be free of labor charges. Priority will be given for Tribal vehicles. There will be not major auto repairs at this time.

The Business Cormittee discussed the plan for the enterprise. Lois made a motion to have Bob Archiquette implement the vehicle maintenance enterprise and that Gordon Skenandore would be the only person working on the vehicles for servicing and that the servicing would be restricted to the eight (8) items listed above. Gordon seconded. Tony abstained. Motion carried.

The Business Committee reviewed the ordinances and made a few minor changes. It was the consensus of the Business Committee that the Ordinances were ready for approval at the Regular meeting scheduled for April 16, 1984.
