WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe desires to dedicate the streets depicted and shown hereon to the City of Green Bay, Wisconsin, for the public use and sewer line purposes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that this subdivision, to be known as Three Sisters Subdivision, be and is hereby accepted and approved by the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin and that the streets depicted and shown hereon are dedicated to the City of Green Bay, Wisconsin for public use and sewer line purposes.
