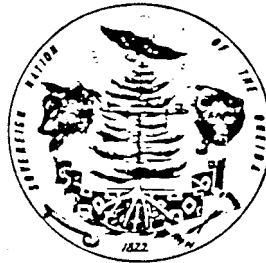


Discussed the need to have a startup report on the Bartholomew collection purchased by the Museum.
