Discussion on Fain Inc. for two lease option:

- 1) Industrial Park
- 2) Carleton Property

Outlots - Recommendation not to purchase Mrs. Karl's, but to keep option on other outlots.

Relocation of Tobacco temporarily on Carleton Property and to make it a C-store.

Discussion on income options.

Flatrate \$100,000 + 25% Gross Revenues
Flatrate \$100,000 + 15% Net Revenues & 10% of Sales

Recommend Flatrate with option to review until lease is signed.

Timing on \$20,000 fee - extend an additional 15 days on option.

Revised option to lease length - 90 days

March 1 - Industrial Park
April 1 - Carleton Property

Finance: Letter of commitment be changed to mini-pirm for 3 year financing.

Settle with present lessors and hold Tribe harmless.
