° ASCA Reso. corn set aside for 145 acres for \$10,500. Ernie Stevens moved to adopt. Loretta Metoxen seconded. Motion carried

Discussion on use of funds for repayment of taxes or other. No decision made.

° Cattle Venture -- Business Plan - Dave Duffin

Discussion of plan. Loss for first 3 years will be picked up by the Land Committee along with a loan of \$129,000. Loretta Metoxen moved to approve the Business Plan for the operation of the Cattle Enterprise, Ernie Stevens seconded. Motion carried.

Lloyd Powless moved that the plan be increased in the area of planning and training, Ernie Stevens seconded. Motion carried.

Rick Hill moved to approve the loan of \$129,000 from the Greenleaf Wayside Bank and that the Tribal Treasurer and other appropriate parties be authorized to complete the paperwork and line of credit. Ernie Stevens seconded. Amelia Cornelius abstained. Motion carried.
