Resolution of 2 Amendments to Tribal Ordinance No. 1

Whereas, the Tribal Housing Ordinance No. 1 which was voted on by the General Tribal Council (at a special session held on April 20, 1963) and

Whereas, the ordinance was adopted with the deletion of Article III e. (3) and the addition of sub-section i, in Article III, and

Whereas, it was not approve by the Public Housing Administration and Bureau of Indian Affairs in Washington, D.C., and,

Whereas, in order to participate in the Program of Public Housing,

Be It Therefore,

Resolved by this General Tribal Council in session assembled at a regular semi-annual meeting, that the Tribal Housing Ordinance No. 1 be amended as follows:

- 1. That in Article III e (3) after the phrase "and all other work in connection," that he following be inserted, "therewith" and the term shall include all other real and personal property and all tangible or intangible assets held or used in connection with the Housing project.
- 2. Under Article III, that the complete sub-section i be deleted, phrase "Reservation shall mean a 20 mile radius beyond the immediate boundary of the reservation," and the definition of reservation shall be restricted to the lands which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Oneida Tribe, pursuant to Article I of the Oneida Constitution.
