

General Tribal Council Resolution No. 67C 9-14-93-A

- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee may be delegated duties and responsibilities by the Oneida General Tribal Council and is at all times subject to the review powers of the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the General Tribal Council has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section I, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Gaming Enterprises are currently implementing Phase II of the Gaming Expansion Plan, and
- WHEREAS, much time and resources are devoted to this project, and
- WHEREAS, because the Oneida Tribal programs and services depend largely on gaming proceeds, and
- WHEREAS, it is desirable that the Gaming budget be finalized first so that all other budgets may be compatible to the Gaming budget, and
- WHEREAS, the Accounting Department is currently addressing the needs of the Tribe's external auditors at this time, and
- WHEREAS, the General Tribal Council requires a definitive budget for their final approval.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Tribal expenditures will continue at the FY '92 level through November, 1992.
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED: That the proposed budget will be presented by the Treasurer to the General Tribal Council for their review and adoption at a General Tribal Council meeting on November 16, 1992.
