

Answer: The Judges in the Trial Court are assigned cases on a rotation basis. If the Judge has a conflict with either litigant, then the case goes to the next Judge on the rotation. If all three (3) Judges have a conflict with one or both of the litigants, then the Chief Trial Court Judge will select a pro tem Judge who is not in conflict from outside the Judiciary to hear the case.
