Colorectal Cancer:

*Is the 3rd most common cancer in the U.S. *The 2nd leading cause of death from cancer *Most common in people age 50 and over *Native American's at increased risk due to lower screening rates *An estimated 136,830 people will be newly diagnosed and cause 50, 310 deaths in 2014 *6 out of 10 deaths could be *prevented* if people 50 and over were screened regularly

Colon Cancer Awareness

Prevention:



*Regular screenings can prevent cancer or find it early when treatment is more successful *Start screenings at age 50 *Make healthy food choices (high fiber, whole wheat, low fat, increase fruit and veggies) *Maintain a healthy weight *Increase daily exercise *Stop smoking *Limit alcohol consumption
