This case has come before the Oneida Tribal Judicial System, Appellate Court. Lead Judicial Officer, Janice L. McLester presiding.

I. Background

The Appellant, Lee Ninham filed a Motion to Dismiss his appeal of his denial by the Oneida Election Board for failure to meet the qualifications required to run for elected position of Chief Trial Judge within the new Judiciary. The Appeal was accepted for review on June 16, 2014.

On June 30, 2014, Appellant filed his Motion to Dismiss without prejudice due to the clarification of qualifications at a June 16, 2014 General Tribal Council meeting.

II. Decision
