ORDER

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable Layatalati Hill presiding.

Background

A complaint was filed on August 18, 2016. On August 26, 2016 the Respondent requested peacemaking. On September 2, 2016 the parties participated in peacemaking and reached an agreement.

Findings

1. That Respondent is an employee of the Oneida Tribe.
2. That the Respondent is subject to the jurisdiction of the Oneida Judiciary.
3. That Respondent's wages are under the control of the Oneida Tribe Accounting Payroll Department.
4. That a valid judgment had been docketed against Respondent in a civil action in a court of competent jurisdiction in the amount of \$720.00.
5. That it is the responsibility of the Respondent and Petitioner to keep a record of total payments applied to this debt. The Accounting Department shall: (a) Send to the Petitioner the allowable amount garnished from the employee's paycheck following each payroll period. (b) Notify the employee and Petitioner when the garnishments are terminated.

Decision

The Court enters the following orders:

1. The Court accepts the peacemaking agreement and incorporates it into this order.
2. A money judgment is awarded in favor of the Petitioner in the amount of \$720.00
3. The Respondent's wages shall be garnished in the amount of \$25.00 each week until the total of \$720.00 is paid in full.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
