JUDGMENT & ORDER

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable Denice E. Beans presiding.

Background

The Petitioner, Rosa F. Smith, filed a complaint on March 8, 2017 against the Respondents: Amanda L. Jackson and Veronica J. Hill. The Petitioner claimed that she put her name on the gas and electric service bills of the Respondent, Amanda L. Jackson and that both Respondents agreed to pay her each month for the gas and electric services. The Petitioner further claimed that she did not receive any payments and that the service for gas and electric were from July 25, 2013 through October 7, 2014. A hearing was held April 7, 2017 at which time all Parties appeared.

Findings of Fact

The court finds as follows:

1. The Court has jurisdiction pursuant to chapter 801 of the Oneida Code of Laws.
2. A hearing was held on April 7, 2017 at 9:00am.
3. All Parties appeared.
4. The Respondent, Amanda L. Jackson, disagreed that she owed the Respondent \$1,018.98 for gas service and \$1,432.70 for electric service at the address of 716 Bond Street during the time of July 25, 2013 through October 7, 2014.

5. The Respondent, Veronica J. Hill, disagreed that she owed the Respondent \$1,018.98 for gas service and \$1,432.70 for electric service at the address of 716 Bond Street during the time of July 25, 2013 through October 7, 2014.
6. The Respondent, Veronica J. Hill, also stated that she never lived at the address of 716 Bond Street during the time of July 25, 2013 through October 7, 2014.
7. All of the Parties agreed to go into Peacemaking.
8. An agreement was reached.
9. The Petitioner agreed to withdraw Veronica J. Hill as a respondent.
10. The stipulation shall be incorporated into the Final Judgment.

Order

The parties stipulated to Judgment for the Petitioner and against the Respondent in the sum of \$1,225.84. The Parties further agree that the Respondent shall make payments of \$150.00 per month within the first 5 days of each month beginning May 2017 and continue until paid in full.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
