

“Dark Secrets of our Food System; know where your food is coming from”

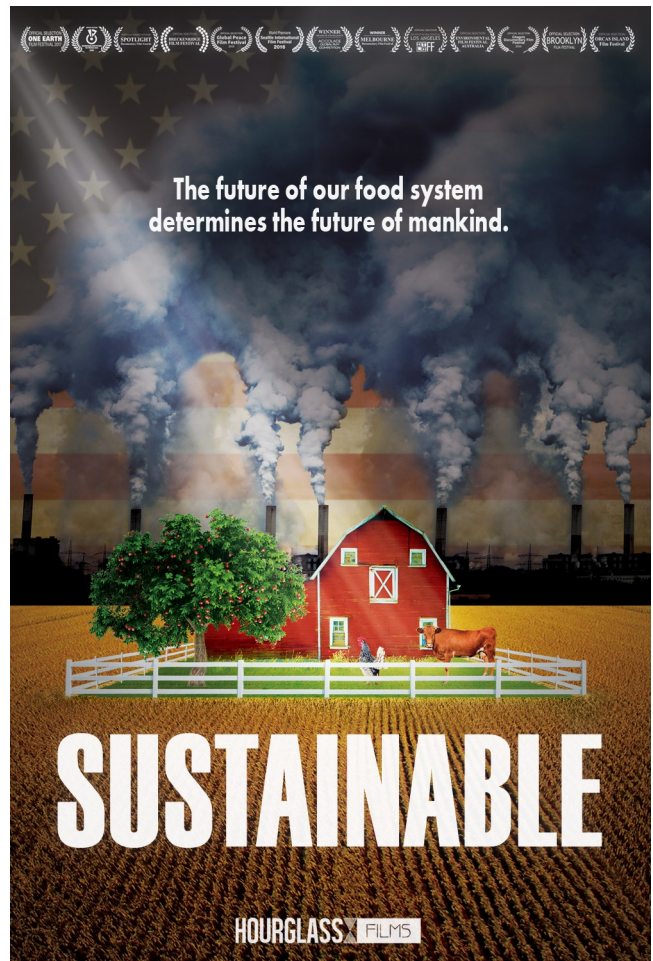
Who: Anyone who is concerned about their health and their food
