- ✓ Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- ✓ Apply for admission to an accredited college/university within the United States
- ✓ Complete your OHE file as early as possible to ensure timely funding

	Acceptance Letter	Apply for admission to an accredited college/university and submit a copy of your acceptance letter	As soon as possible
	(FAFSA) Free Application for Federal Student Aid <i>(Not required for students taking 1-5 credits per semester/term, but recommended)</i>	File annually for each academic school year at: www.fafsa.gov	File as soon after January 1 of each year.
	Oneida Higher Education (OHE) 1. Application 2. Participation Acknowledgement & Agreement Form	Complete annually for each academic school year, when you change schools or degrees	Priority dates: April 15 (fall) October 1 (spring) May 1 (summer)
	Oneida Academic Plan	Student and advisor/counselor must sign as soon as you register for classes <i>(or when you add/drop classes)</i>	For each semester/term
	Oneida Financial Needs Analysis (FNA)	OHE will send this form to the school's financial aid office to obtain the school's cost of attendance and students financial aid information	
	Official Transcript of grades	<i>For students who previously received funding.</i> OHE students must request an “official” transcript be sent directly to OHE	After each semester/term

Eligible Degrees	Length of Funding	Grade Point Requirement
Vocational/Technical (Associate)	2.5 years	2.0 semester/term GPA
Undergraduate (Bachelors)	5 Years	2.0 semester/term GPA
Graduate	3 Years	3.0 semester/term GPA
Doctorate	5 years	3.0 semester/term GPA
