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## 1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. The ONEIDA NATION, Selection Committee hereby requests Proposals from qualified firms to provide Design/Build services for the proposed State Farm Grazing project. Upon receipt of the Proposals the Selection Committee will review statements and select a firm based upon the selection procedure identified in section seven of this RFP.
- 1.2. The Selection Committee consists of the following individuals: Senior Architect, the Environmental project manager, DPW - Facilities Representatives, and Oneida Nation Farm representatives.
- 1.3. Questions regarding this RFP should be directed to the appropriate individual listed below, prior to the submittal date.

## 2. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

2.1. GENERAL DESCRIPTION: The proposed project will construct (1)- 30' x 370' single sloped agricultural structure which will provide sheltered space for different aged dairy heifers. The project site will need to be developed for new and future structures. In addition; two pump house structures are to be constructed to house items such as: pressure tank, control box, heater and electrical equipment.

## 2.2. PROJECT IMAGE & GOALS:

- 2.2.1. The new barn will provide facilities to optimize health, handle cattle in the most humane and stress free manor possible, allow employees to work in a safe environment and to improve labor efficiency.
- 2.2.2. The Oneida Nation plans to lease building to a local dairy farmer.

### 2.3. BUILDING DESIGN REQUIREMENTS:

- 2.3.1. Construction documents were completed by McMahon Engineers/ Architects in 2017 for the barn. Refer to Project Scope document.
- 2.3.2. The facility shall be functional.
- 2.3.3. The construction of the project shall conform, or exceed, all codes and restrictions specified by the USDA-NRCS, Oneida Building Code, Oneida Zoning Ordinance and other codes pertinent to the facility.
- 2.3.4. Refer to Project Scope document in Appendix.

2.4. SITE SELECTION: The project site is located along County Rd U in the Town of Oneida, WI. Development would occur on multiple parcels owned by Oneida Nation. The properties are currently used for agricultural purposes.

## 2.5. SITE DESIGN REQUIREMENTS:

- 2.5.2. Oneida has commissioned soil borings and will be available to awarded firm. Incorporate geotechnical recommendations as provided by ECS Midwest, LLC if applicable.

## 5. SELECTION PROCEDURE

5.1. The completed Proposal Form will be reviewed for completeness to determine if all submission requirements were met. Failure to submit complete documents may result in the Proposal being rejected. In the event that all Proposals are judged incomplete, the ONEIDA NATION reserves the right to select the Proposal(s) which in its opinion most nearly meets all the requirements of this Request for Proposals.

- 5.2. The completed Proposal Forms will be reviewed and scored by each Selection Committee member. The criteria for scoring are based upon the Proposal requirements identified in paragraph 5.3. The highest scoring firm will be invited to begin the contract award process.
  - 5.2.1. In the event the Selection Committee does not have consensus that the high scoring firm is the appropriate choice, then the Oneida Nation reserves the right to invite the two or three highest scoring firms to be interviewed by the Selection Committee.
- 5.3. The criteria for scoring are based upon the submittal requirements identified on the Proposal Form with the following relative importance of the criteria:

5.4. All firms submitting proposals will receive a summary of the scoring results.

## 6. CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

- 6.1. The selected firm will execute an Oneida Nation Standard Construction Agreement with a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP).
  - 6.2. The firm selected for this contract will be required to obtain an Oneida Vendor's License, prior to being given notice to proceed with the work. The annual fee for the license is due upon application, contact the Oneida Licensing Department at 920-496-5311.
    - 6.2.1. An Oneida Vendor's License is not required for submission.
  - 6.3. Oneida Indian Preference Law; basically this law requires contracts entered into by the Oneida Nation must apply Indian Preference for goods and services. Preference is intended to give an advantage to Indian-owned companies and Native American employees in contracting. It is our practice to include Indian Preference as one of the scored selection criteria. Firms utilizing Indian-owned

consultants, employing tribal members, and/or Indian-owned firms will receive scores in the Indian Preference category.

6.3.1. The firm selected for this contract will be contractually obligated to abide by the ONEIDA NATION's Indian Preference in Contracting Law. A Copy of which is included in the Scope of Work document.
