JUDGMENT

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable John E. Powless III presiding.

BACKGROUND

A complaint was filed by the Petitioner on February 7, 2018. A hearing was scheduled March 15, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. Due to an agreed upon Stipulation and Agreement, the Petitioner requested to cancel the scheduled hearing.

FINDING OF FACTS

1. The Court has subject matter, personal and territorial jurisdiction over this matter.
2. The Court finds good cause to cancel the scheduled hearing on March 15, 2018.

STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

The Court approves the Stipulation and Agreement as follows:


1. The Court grants the Petitioners request to cancel hearing due to the Stipulation and Agreement between the parties.
2. A Fine of \$75.00 and court costs of \$25.00 totaling \$100.00 shall be due by the Defendant in 90 days from the date this Judgment is signed.
3. Licensure of Smokey shall be completed within 90 days from the date this Judgment is signed.
4. Proof of licensure shall be submitted to the Attorney to the Petitioner within 90 days from the date this Judgment is signed.

5. Failure to comply with this Judgment and attached Stipulation and Agreement will result in the Stipulation and Agreement being nullified and the citation fine of \$500.00 (2nd Offense) and court costs of \$25.00 totaling \$525.00 shall be reinstated.

The parties have the right to appeal within thirty (30) calendar days after the date this order or judgement is signed.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

5.) I understand that the above fine/ forfeiture constitutes debt owed to a tribal entity and nonpayment is subject to Tribal remedy.




