JUDGMENT

This case has come before the Oneida Trial Court, Honorable John E. Powless III presiding.

BACKGROUND

A complaint was filed by the Petitioner on May 8, 2018. A Pre-Trial hearing was held on June 21, 2018. A hearing was scheduled August 3, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. Due to an agreed upon Stipulation and Agreement, the Petitioner requested to cancel the scheduled hearing.

FINDING OF FACTS

1. The Court has subject matter, personal and territorial jurisdiction over this matter.
2. The Court finds good cause to cancel the scheduled hearing on August 3, 2018.

STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT


The Court approves the Stipulation and Agreement as follows:

1. The Court grants the Petitioners request to cancel hearing due to the Stipulation and Agreement between the parties.
2. A Fine of \$25.00 and court costs of \$25.00 totaling \$50.00 shall be due by the Defendant in 60 days from the date this Judgment is signed.
3. Declaration of Dangerousness is withdrawn, no "damage" to neighbor dog. Owner installed reinforced fence.
5. Failure to comply with this Judgment and attached Stipulation and Agreement is subject to Tribal Law and remedy.

The parties have the right to appeal within thirty (30) calendar days after the date this order or judgement is signed.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
