

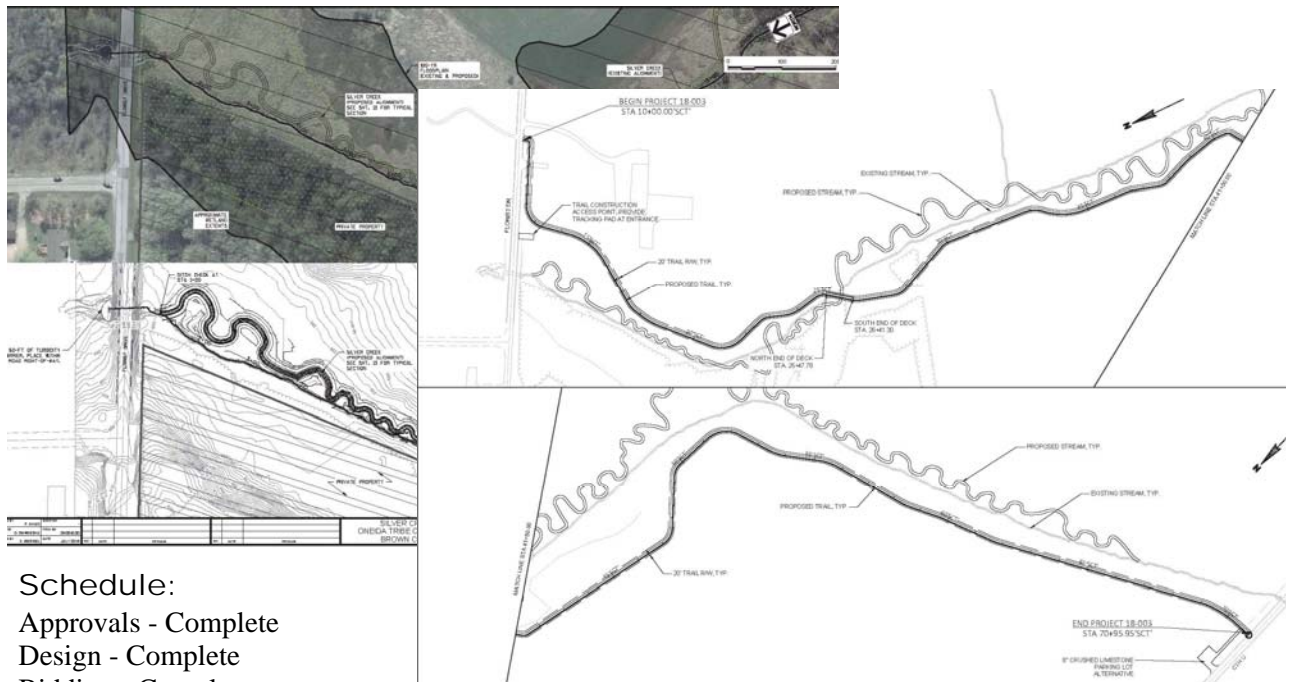
ENG# 18-003 - Oneida Community Trails | Silver Creek

Project Description:

The project consists of two items, a pedestrian trail and stream restoration to Silver Creek. The Silver Creek trail will feature gentle curves, slopes, aggregate type paving, and a pedestrian bridge crossing over Silver Creek (historically known as Bread Creek). This trail will promote walking and bicycling recreational activities in a new riparian corridor highlighted by newly implemented tree plantings and environmental restoration projects. It will be an appealing transportation alternative that supports a healthy and active lifestyle with future aims to connect to other Oneida Natural Areas and the Oneida Lake. Enhancing recreational opportunities is a proven way to reduce chronic diseases and increase community development and quality of life. The Silver Creek trail will be a positive addition to Oneida as a whole and especially to the local Oneida neighborhoods built on the premise that each neighborhood has a unique design with access to nature, connected to the community, and built to enhance the quality of life of residents who live there. The creek restoration shall consist of earthwork, environmental controls, dewatering, and stream bed stone. The trail work shall consist of trail construction, prefabricated pedestrian bridge, culverts, signing, and pavement marking.

Current Status:

Due to the heavy rainfalls our area has received, the project site conditions would not allow activity to commence this Fall. Both projects are on hold until site conditions allow equipment access and work to commence. We anticipate work will commence Summer 2020.
