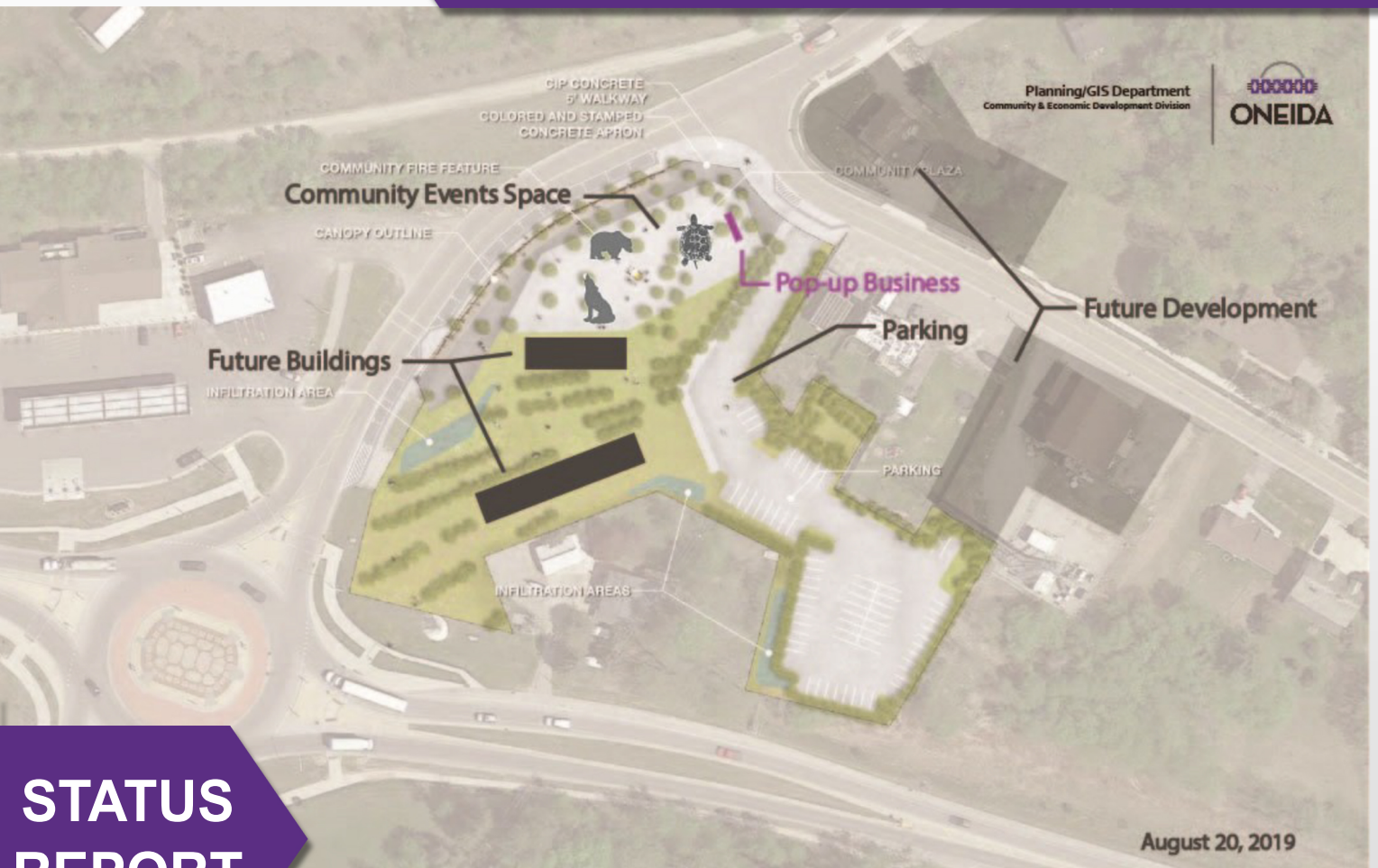


Upper Oneida Transportation Project



STATUS REPORT

Project Description

The project has been the vision of the Oneida community and organization for the last several years. Phase one the project, which is mostly funded with Tribal Transportation (TTP) Road Funds, is a critical first step that will set the tone for the future. This will be more than just a passive row of street trees within a utility strip, rather it is a hybrid between a social gathering space and small business development. This new piece of community infrastructure will be part of several amenities adjacent and integrated into the Duck Creek trail. This space will serve as a programmatic platform for dining, conversing, storytelling, community fire, safe movement and entrepreneurial activity. The entire site development will be in multiple phases.
