This case has come before the Oneida Tribal Judicial System, Trial Court. Judicial Officers, Mary Adams, Jean M. Webster, and Leland Wigg-Ninham, presiding.

**I Background**

This case involves a request for a Temporary Restraining Order against the Respondent, Oneida Housing Authority. Petitioner currently resides at N6475 Deer Path Drive, Oneida. Petitioner claims she was issued a decision to vacate the premises on or before 4:30 p.m., Friday, August 12, 2011.

The parties requested a sixty (60) day stay, the Court granted the stay. A hearing was scheduled for Wednesday, October 12, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. to address the matter.

Attorney, Patricia Garvey, filed on behalf of the Respondent a Motion to Stay. The Court granted the Respondent's motion to stay until November 3, 2011 at 9:00 a.m.

November 1, 2011, Attorney Patricia Garvey filed a Motion for Continuance. The Court grants the Respondent's Motion for Continuance until December 6, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.

## II Decision

The Court grants Respondent's Motion for Continuance. The new Court date is December 6, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.
