Order


This petition has come before the Oneida Tribal Judicial System Trial Court, Leland Wigg-Ninham, Anita Barber, and Gerald Cornelius presiding.

Background

Petitioner filed a claim against the Respondents on January 30th, 2007. Petitioner is claiming the Respondents breached their contract agreement to purchase a 2004 Chevrolet. Petitioner is requesting the court to issue a repossession order and direct the Oneida Police Department to take possession of the property and deliver it to the Petitioner. A hearing was held on March 16, 2007. As a result of that hearing, the court determined it did not have jurisdiction over this matter. The court further stated that based on our lack of a code or ordinance, and unless we receive an objection from either party persuading the court to do otherwise, the panel would dismiss this action.

Order
