Decision

This case has come before the Oneida Tribal Judicial System, Trial Court. Judicial Officers, Mary Adams, Stanley R. Webster, and Leland Wigg-Ninham, presiding.

I Background

This case involves an injury that allegedly happened at work. Employee sought medical attention with an Orthopedic Specialist, which was covered by Worker's Compensation. Further coverage was denied when Petitioner reached the "end of healing" date.


On February 11, 2008 Petitioner, Grace E. Schindel, filed a petition against Respondent, Oneida HRD-Benefits and Crawford, for allegedly denying her claim for worker's compensation to cover her wages, transportation/mileage and medical expenses. Respondent asserted that Petitioner's claims were paid excluding wages for employment outside of the Oneida Tribe until the Independent Medical Examination (IME) reported her "end of healing" date of January 1, 2008.

On March 6, 2008 Petitioner filed a Motion to Dismiss stating she is comfortable with the resolution reached with Respondent and no longer wishes to pursue this action. The Court grants Petitioner's Motion to Dismiss in accordance with Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 14(A) Voluntary Dismissal.



II Decision

The Court grants Petitioner's Motion to Dismiss. This case is dismissed without prejudice.
