
The Petitioners assert all current and former Oneida Appeals Commissioners are a conflict of interest to hear and decide the case. The Petitioners make this request based upon the fact the case has the ability to directly affect and impact the Oneida Appeals Commissioners (past & present), their immediate family members, extended families, their friends and their associates with real or perceived by the general population of Oneida Tribal Members

We, the Petitioners, also respectfully move the Oneida Appeals Commission to assign Pro tempore or pro tem judges to hear and decide the matter. The Petitioners respectfully request pro tem judges experienced and familiar with the content and application of relevant rules and precedents and who have a reputation for fairness among their colleagues. The Petitioners respectfully request that Richard Ackley, Associate Judge, Bad River Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Tribal Court, not be allowed to act as a pro tem judge for this case.


The Petitioners further request all persons assigned to hear and decide the case not be Oneida, enrolled or otherwise. Further, that no person assigned to hear and decide the matter be an Oneida descendent of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin. Further, that no person assigned to the case be related to, married to, friends with, associate to, etc. of an Oneida or Oneida descendent. Lastly, that all conflict of interest policies, procedures, laws, ordinances, etc. be enforced to the fullest extent allowable to ensure a fair, objective and independent hearing and decision.
